- Uneven temporary winter tees HGK believes these are level however some works were carried out to 1st Tee (temp winter tee) on Tuesday 12th January
- 2. "Broad brush" maintenance plan requested, no dates required (as per minutes of AGM)

Annual Maintenance Plan

Spring – repair & re-open 18th hole bridge, Greens maintenance & top dressing hopefully March/April – weather dependent – hired in equipment is provisionally booked for 23/24 March

Summer – cutting and routine maintenance

Autumn – dependent on progress with existing projects as advised in Greens Liaison Report 2021

Winter – reintroduction of temporary tees as required by Course conditions

- 3. Bridge on 18th hole repair and re-opening HGK advises this will be carried out this Spring
- Air compressor needs attention/cleaning? Only one hose was present

 new parts obtained; second hose was reinstalled before Tues 12th
 January
- Tee box on the right on 7th hole could this not be used as a winter tee? Declined by HGK, requires the flexibility to relocate the temporary tee dependent on wear and tear created
- 6. Are there any plans to put temporary tees next to all holes? HGK advises there are no plans to put temporary tees next to main tees as all traffic would go to the same spot all the time; by moving tees as requires, he is better able to manage the wear and tear to the course Please do not hesitate to contact me during the year with any further queries regarding the course.
